

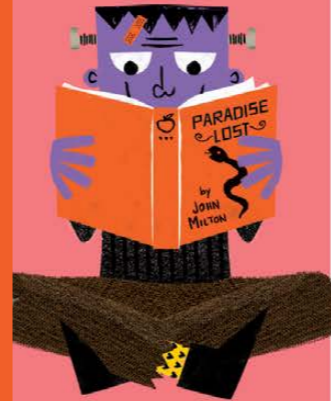

B is for Becky



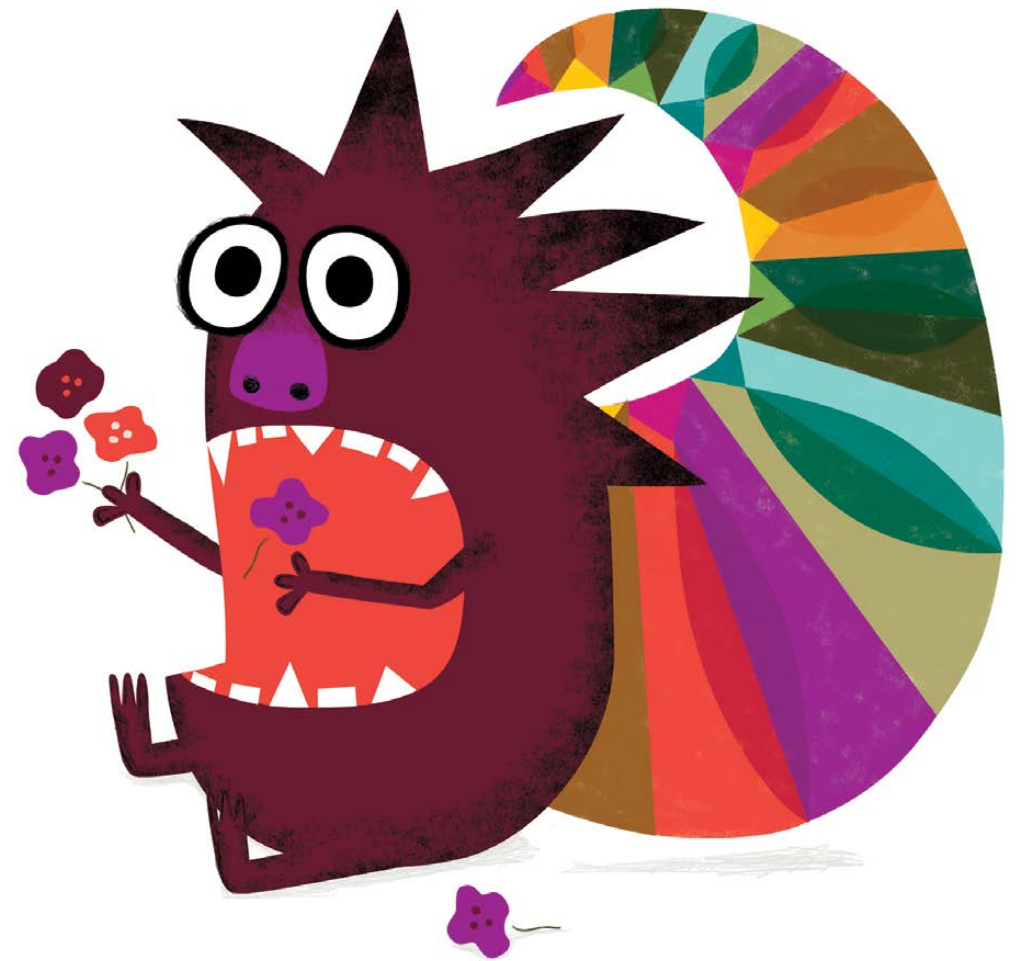
Becky is a serving girl and Sara Crewe's friend in *A Little Princess*.

J is for Jabberwock



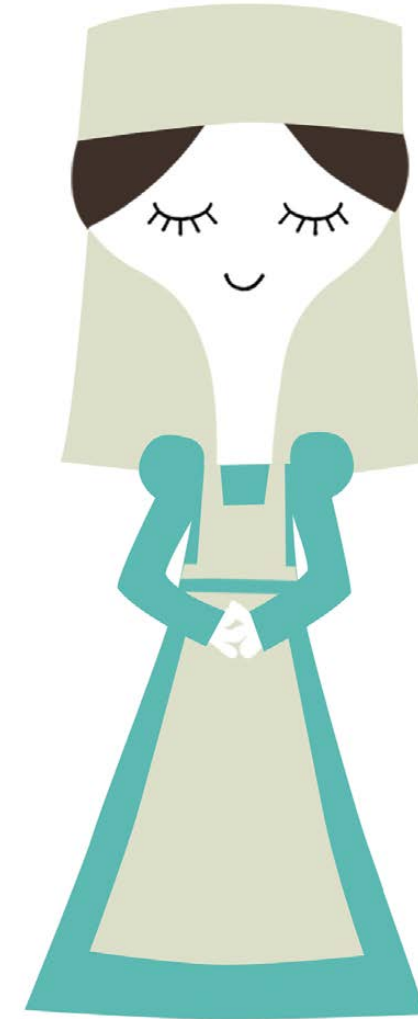
The Jabberwock is a monster in Lewis Carroll's
