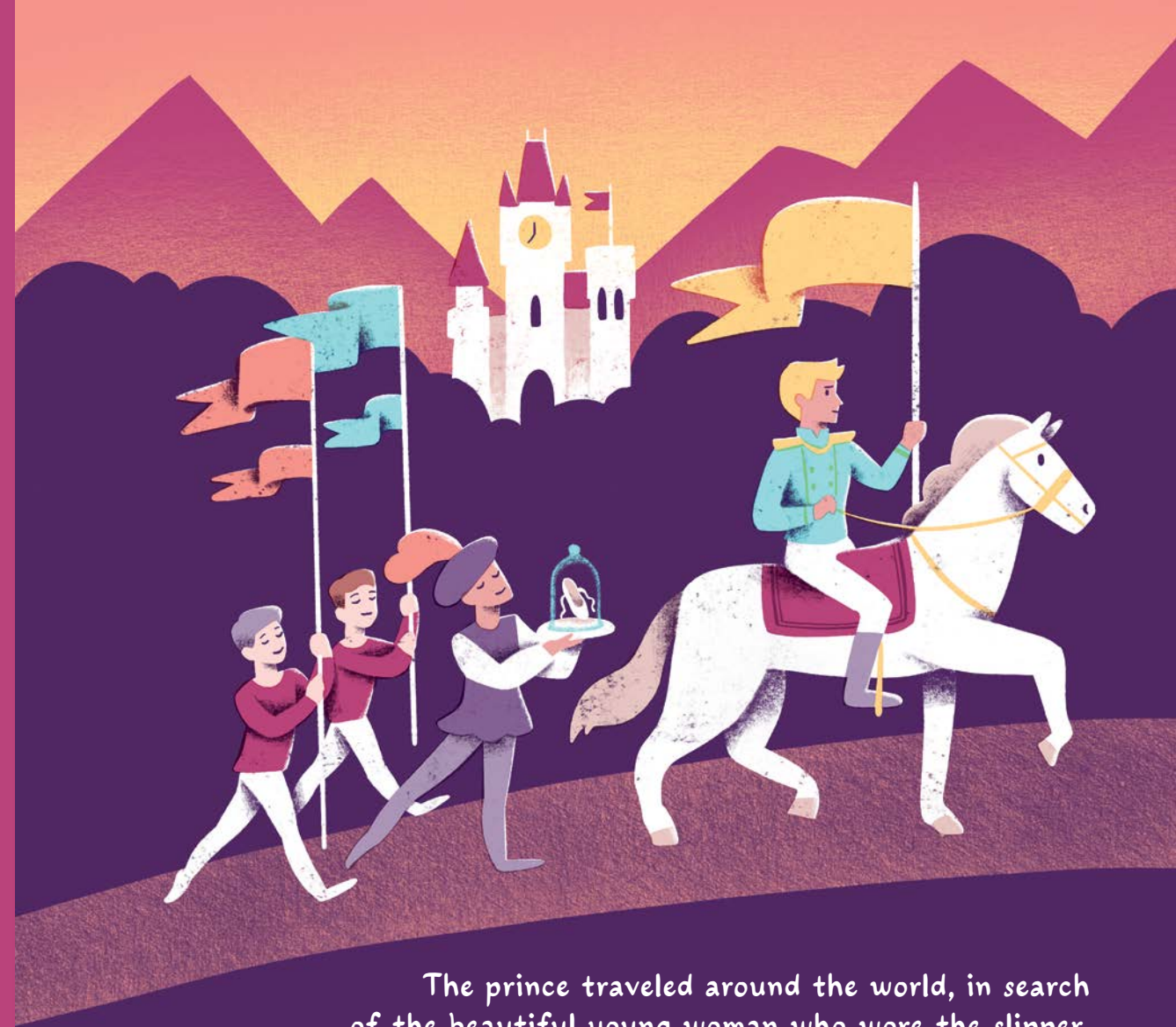


At the ball, all the gentlemen and ladies were astonished by Cinderella's beauty and good graces.
