


is for Frito Fried




"Gimel" is the phonetic for the Hebrew letter, "g," of the dreidel. If you land on gimel, you get to take the jackpot!



"Guímel" es la fonética de la letra hebrea "g" del dreidel. Si caes en guímel, ¡te llevas el premio mayor!










You make a home with your family and friends once the celebration begins.

is for Latke

Latke is a word in Hebrew that comes from Russian, translating to "little pancake." It is a fried potato pancake that is traditionally accompanied by applesauce and sour cream as dips. The crispier, the better!

is for Menoral Menorah



A menorah is a candleholder with eight main branches, plus the raised ninth lamp set apart as the shamash light used to kindle the other lights.

Una menorá es un candelabro con ocho ramas principales, más la novena lámpara elevada que se aparta como luz del shamash que se utiliza para encender las otras luces.

Hanukkah is celebrated over the course of eight nights because of the miraculous oil that lasted for eight nights. Each night at sundown, noche, al ocaso, la familia y los family and friends gather to light a candle for that day.

Janucá se celebra durante ocho noches debido al aceite milagroso que duró ocho noches. Cada amigos se reúnen para encender la vela de ese día.
