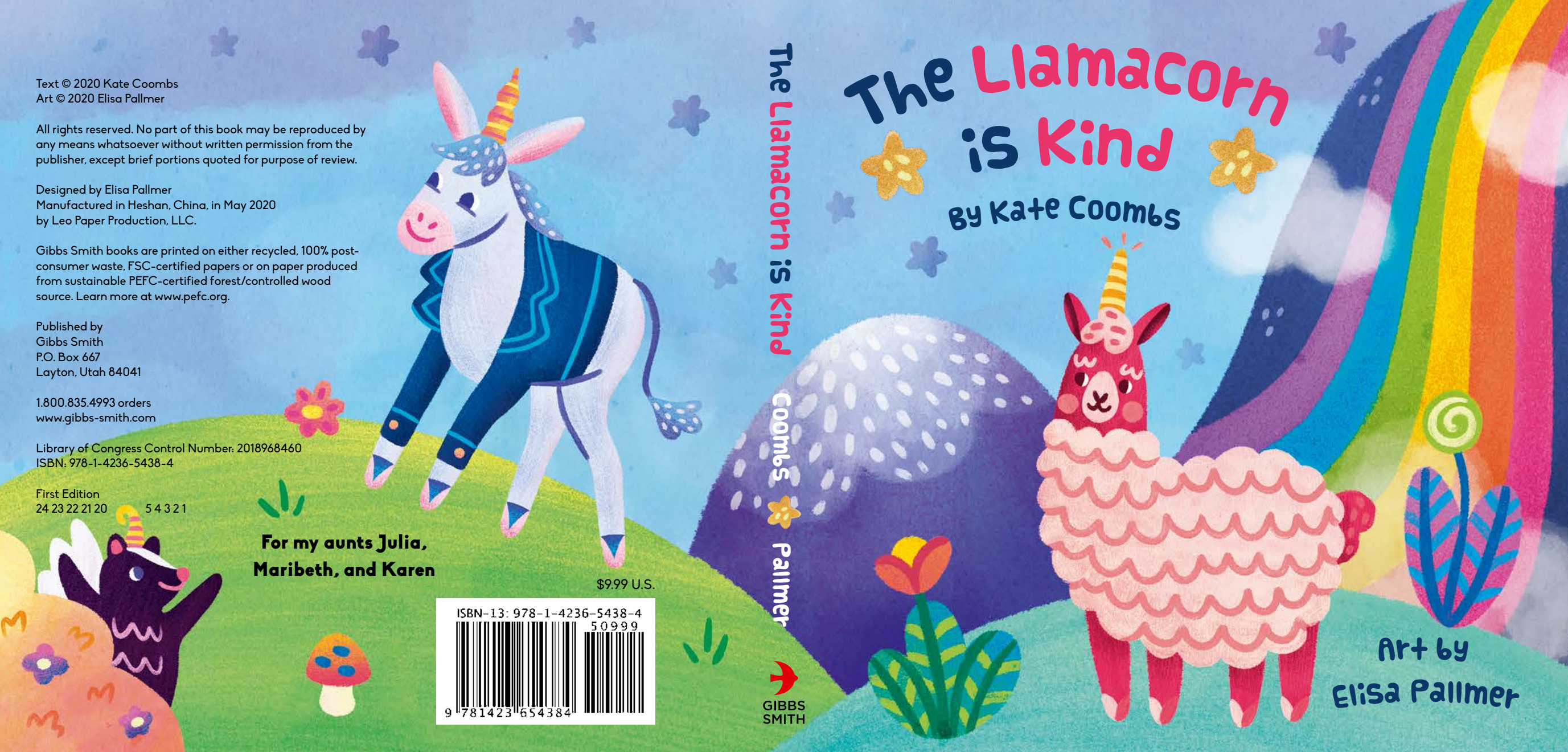

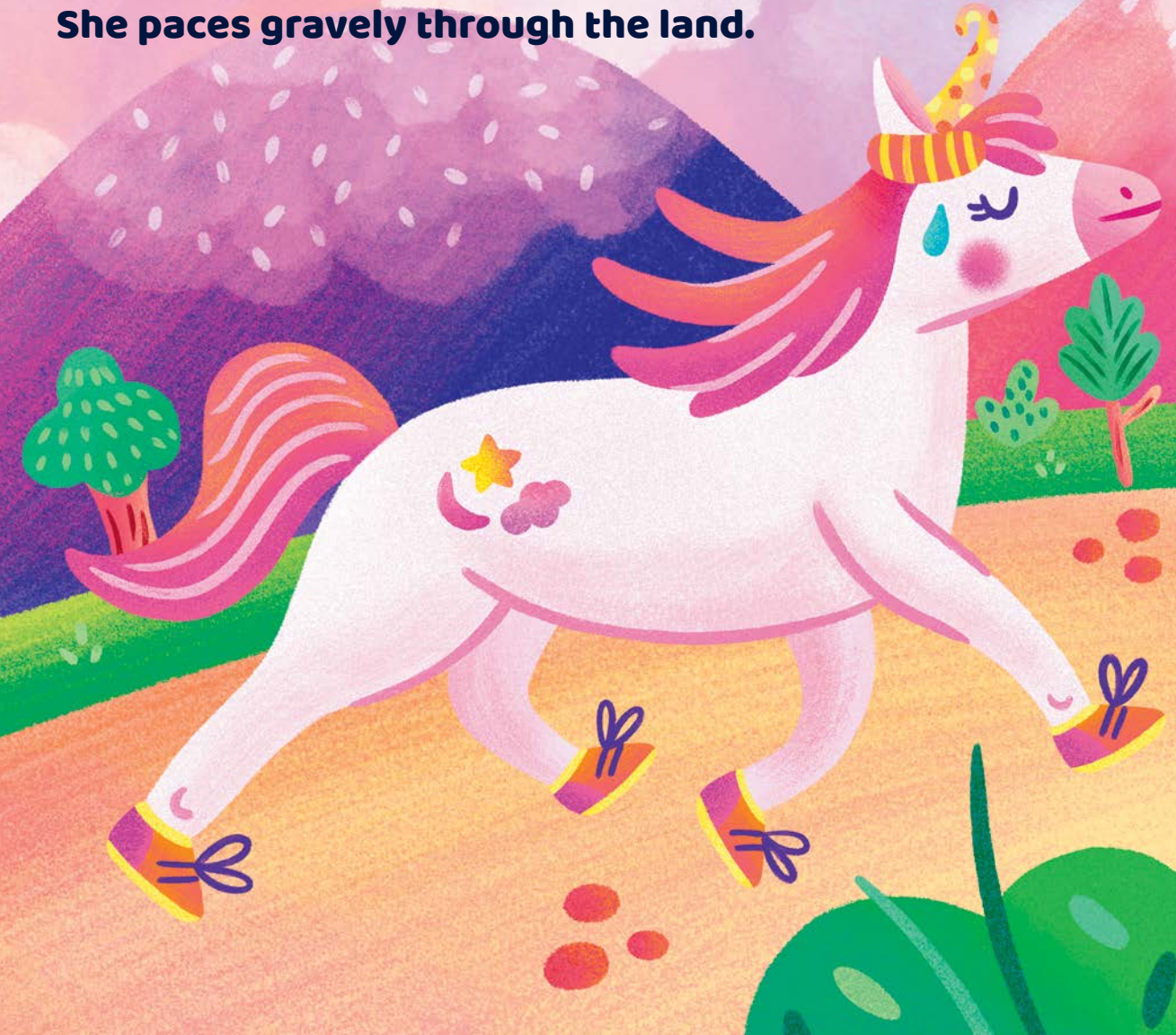

But the **llamacorn** is kind.

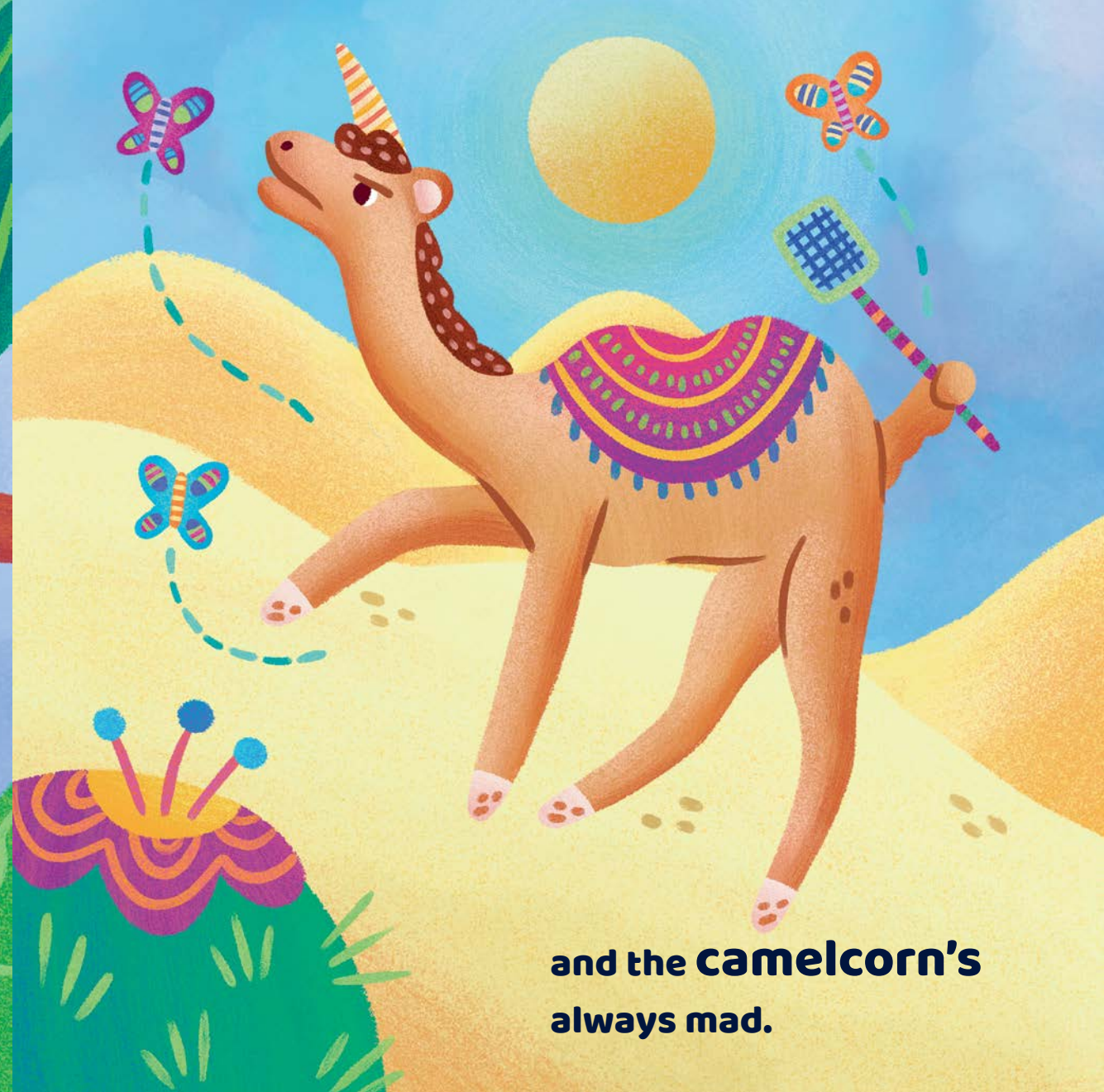




The gorillacorn is sad.
