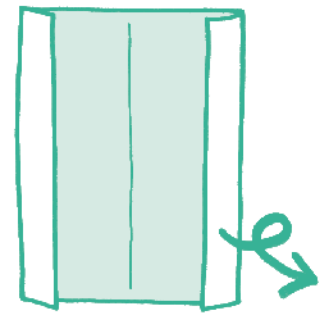
1 Color side up, fold in half down the middle. Unfold.



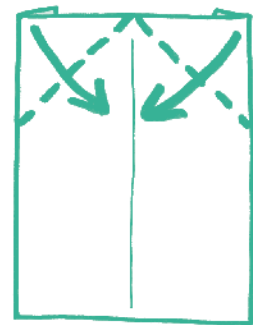
2 Mark the quarter points along the top edge by bringing the top corners to the top center line and pinching the edge.



3 Fold the left and right edges to the quarter pinches . . .



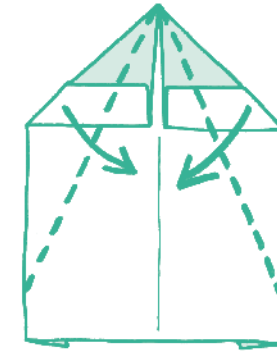
4 . . . like this. Turn over.



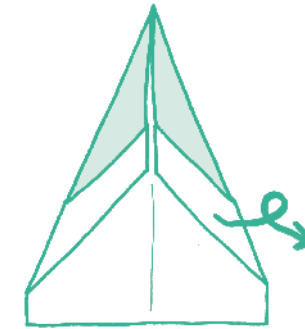
5 Fold the top corners to the center line.



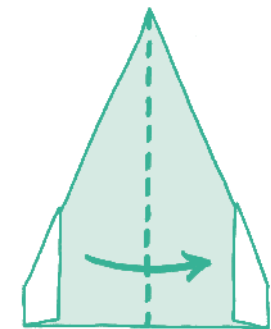

6 Fold in the sloping edges to the center line . . .



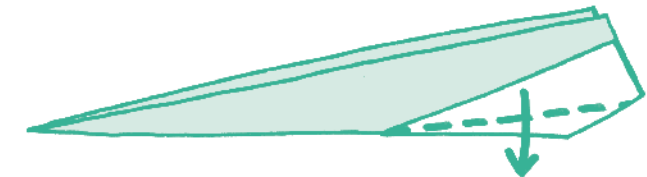
7 . . . like this. Turn over again.



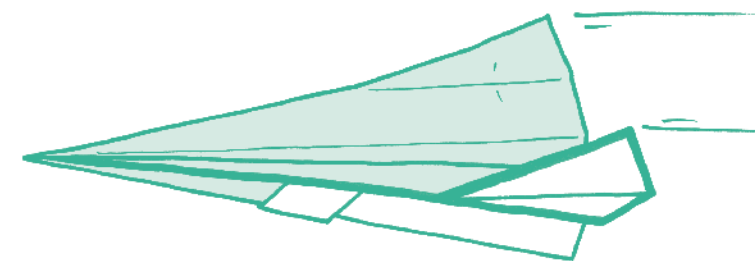
8 Fold the paper in half.



9 Fold the sloping edge to the bottom edge, making a sharp corner at the left. Repeat behind.



10 Fold the loose corner upwards at 90 degrees. Repeat behind.



Flying Tips

Check that the small vertical fins are upright and the wings are horizontal. Throw upwards with some force. Carefully trimmed, it will fly a long way.
