






One Room at a Time 206

Lively objects that reflect and ricochet light around the room create vibrancy, which elevates your living space. Find ways to capture the sun using found objects, large or small.

OPPOSITE, CLOCKWISE FROM TOP LEFT: LED lighting edges pencil-thin rings on this fixture, which seems to hover in midair. A Buddha graces the coffee table. Nailhead trim makes an artful statement. A gilt trunk doubles as an end table and storage. OVERLEAF: Fifteen-foot-high ceilings give this family room and open kitchen an airy feel.
