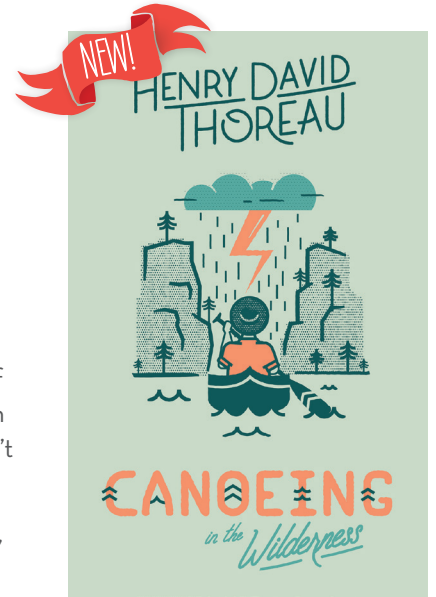
CANOEING IN THE WILDERNESS

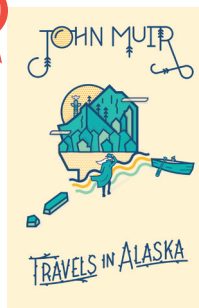

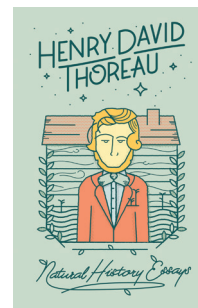

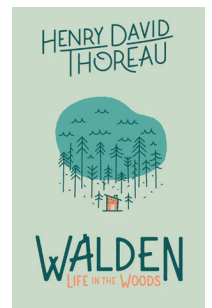
